Meals

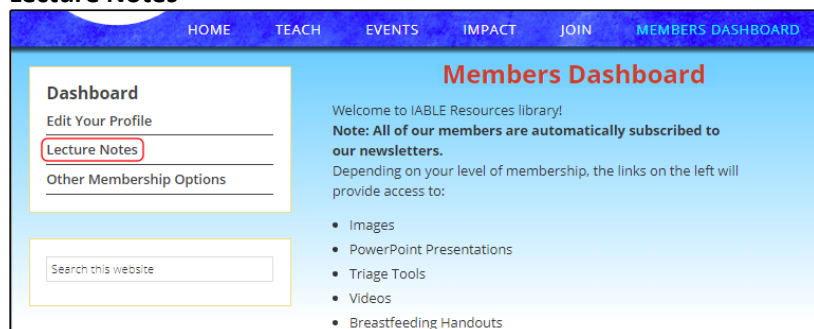
Lunch is on your own.
