Welcome,

Thank you for choosing to join the Newman Regional Health (NRH) My HEALTH INFO patient portal.

The portal can be accessed by going to the web address:

www.newmanrh.org

The following information is required to enroll in My HEALTH INFO:

- Your NRH Medical Record number (entered exactly as provided) or SSN
- Your personal home email address
- Name
- Date of birth
- Social Security Number

*Please note: You must be 12+ years old to setup a portal account with Newman Regional Health. In order to enroll in the Newman Regional Health My HEALTH INFO, **the name you enter must be what is currently on file in our electronic medical record and your email address must also be on file in our electronic medical record.** You can update your email address in person with our Registration staff when you are registering for a hospital visit or Newman Regional Health Medical Partners visit. Otherwise, you will need to come to our Health Information Management Department at Newman Regional Health or email portalHIM@newmanrh.org. We are open from Mon-Fri from 8:00am -4:30pm. You will be required to present a photo Id.*

How to Enroll and Log-in Your First Time

1. Open your preferred web browser and enter the web address www.newmanrh.org in the address bar. Click on 'MY HEALTH RECORDS' button on the home page.
2. Click '*Login Here*', then click the [Sign up](#) link below the login fields on the next screen.
3. Complete all the information on the enrollment form. Medical Record Number must be entered as it appears on handout received during registration.

**Patient Portal Terms of Use
Policy and Procedures

Patient Agreement to Abide by Terms of Use**

The Newman Memorial County Hospital is a Newman Regional Health ("NRH"), a Kansas county hospital organized pursuant to K.S.A. § 19-4901 et. seq. offers secure viewing through our MyHealthInfo portal, as a service to patients who wish to view parts of their records. Online access to confidential information can be a valuable communications tool, but has certain risks. By accepting the Agreement to Abide by the Terms of Use, you accept the risks and agree to follow Terms of Use, as described below.

I. Terms of Use - General Policies and Procedures

DO NOT use MyHealthInfo to communicate (i) an emergency, (ii) an urgent issue or (iii) sensitive information (e.g. HIV, mental health, work-excuses, etc.)

Proper Subject Matter:

- Use MyHealthInfo for: lab results, imaging reports, appointments, billing information, etc.
- Use MyHealthInfo to update your demographic information.
- Be sure that all information that you enter is true, accurate, complete, and updated whenever there is a change.
- Be concise when typing a message.

8. To access the Newman Regional Health My HEALTH INFO again, return to the My HEALTH RECORDS section of www.newmanrh.org and click on the 'Login Here' button.

Frequently Asked Questions:

What should I do if I forget my password?

From the My HEALTH INFO Log-In screen, there is a 'Forgot Password' link. By selecting this link and identifying the email address that is on file for you, a one-time user/password will be emailed to you. You may then logon with this one-time user/password and will then be prompted to update this user name/password and determine a security question and response for your user.

What if I forgot my Logon ID?

To confirm your My HEALTH INFO Logon ID, you need to call the Health Information Management Department at Newman Regional Health, 620-343-5941 or email portalHIM@newmanrh.org.

What should I do if I have other technical problems with My HEALTH INFO?

By selecting, 'Contact Us' on the My HEALTH INFO homepage you can submit a question or call 620-343-5941 and select the option for portal technical support.

Is my username case sensitive?

No, your username (Logon ID) for My HEALTH INFO is not case sensitive; however, passwords are case sensitive.

How do I log out?

Click the 'Log Off' link at the top right side of the page. The 'Logon' screen will appear verifying that you logged out successfully. You may then exit from the My HEALTH INFO page.

As a parent or guardian how will I be able to see a family members medical information?

You will be able to apply for proxy access to a family member's information, who is between the age of birth to 11. From within the portal under the Profile section, the Shared Access feature can be used to grant others access to your medical record information on the portal.
