- Upper and lower extremity fracture care
- Shoulder:: Minimally-invasive shoulder surgery for rotator cuff repair, labrum repair, Latarjet shoulder stabilization, coracoclavicular ligament reconstruction, pec tendon repair, and anatomic and reverse total shoulder replacement
- Elbow: Minimally invasive management of medial and lateral epicondylitis (golfer's and tennis elbow), collateral ligament reconstruction and repair, management of elbow dislocations, biceps tendon repair, triceps tendon repair, olecranon bursitis management, and arthroscopic management of elbow arthritis
- Hip: Minimally-invasive hip preservation surgery for femoroacetabular impingement (FAI) with labrum debridement and repair. He also performs open abductor and hamstring tendon repair and direct anterior total hip replacement.
- Knee/ leg: Minimally-invasive knee surgery for cartilage and meniscus injuries including osteochondral allograft and meniscal transplantation, ACL/PCL/MCL/LCL repair and reconstruction, patella dislocation, osteotomy for angular and rotational deformity around the knee, quadriceps and patella tendon repair, and robotic assisted total knee replacement, Achilles tendon repair
