

Nurse EXTERNSHIP

Six weeks of paid time with RN preceptor

Qualifications:

Nursing students who are actively enrolled, and in good standing, in an Accredited Nursing Program, with an anticipated graduation date of December 2026 or May 2027, are eligible to apply.

This position provides a summer learning experience for qualified nursing students. The nurse extern will work side by side with a licensed Registered Nurse (RN) preceptor for approximately six weeks.

Potential primary areas for student rotations include:

Emergency Department, Obstetrics, ICU, Medical/Surgical/Telemetry, Inpatient Rehab, and Clinical Decision Unit.

Final nursing unit assignments will be determined in May and are subject to change based on organizational staffing and preceptor availability.

The Nurse Extern will work under the direct supervision of a Registered Nurse (RN) to provide patient care.

- Work within the nursing process to deliver direct patient care across various age groups, which may include neonate, pediatric, adolescent, adult, and geriatric populations.
- Perform patient assessments and nursing procedures specific to areas of practice in a safe, efficiently manner, demonstrating appropriate technical skill.
- Administer medications safely and accurately in accordance with organizational policy.
- Document pertinent patient assessments, interventions, and outcomes in a timely and accurate manner.
- Nurse Externs are expected to work the same shift as their assigned RN preceptor, which may include days, nights, and weekend shifts.
